
















# ACETAMINOPHEN DOSING FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN

This guide will help you give your child the right amount of acetaminophen.

- If possible, use weight to dose your child; otherwise, use age.
- Give every 4-6 hours as needed for fever or pain.
- Do NOT give more than 4 doses in a 24-hour period.
- Do NOT use with any other medicines containing acetaminophen.

<b>72-95 LBS</b> (33-43 KILOGRAMS) <b>11 YEARS</b>			 6 tablets	 3 tablets
